From *Larousse Gastronomique (1938)* "The origins of restaurants, as we know them, is not very old. In the eighteenth century one could eat only in the inns... or at the shops of the *traiteurs* (eating house keepers) who could only sell whole pieces. In 1765 a man named Boulanger gave to his soups the name 'Restaurants,' i.e. **Restoratives** and inscribed on his sign "Boulanger sells magical restoratives." "Restoratives" was derived from a medical term meaning "To give strength or vigor."
